Bus Committee Policy

May 2022

Purpose: Supervises maintenance and operation, schedules, and approves uses of buses.

Guidelines:

- 1. Buses may be used for church related activities by First Baptist Church and possibly may be loaned to other churches and organizations. **THIS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BUS COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.**
- 2. Passengers are NOT allowed to talk to the drivers while the bus is underway.
- 3. Non-Christian behavior will NOT be tolerated on buses.
- 4. Empty food or drink containers are to be placed in the trash containers.
- 5. No tobacco (in any form) allowed on the buses.
- 6. Buses will not be used for personal trips or errands.
- 7. Damages to the interior of the buses will be charged to individuals responsible. If children are responsible the parents will be held liable for any damages.
- 8. All reservations for buses should be made through the church office.
- 9. The buses are property of First Baptist Church and because many drivers and riders will use them, we strongly suggest that a sense of pride in their use be established. We can't make that happen- only those who use them can. Please treat them as id they belonged to you personally.
- 10. Drivers must be 21 years of age or older with a clean driving record. The church office must have on file the following information for the drivers: Full name, drivers license number and date of birth. Drivers must have a CDL with passenger endorsement.
- 11. Drivers are responsible for the following:
 - a. Check out (during office hours) and return of keys with approval from buses through the church office.

- b. Maintenance check for gas, oil, and water when taking buses on a trip out of town. Vehicles will be checked otherwise on a weekly basis (except for gas).
- c. Cleaning/picking up all trash and personal items at the end of day or trip.
- d. Parking buses in parking lot at end of day or trip.
- e. Securing all windows and doors (including rear door) after parking buses.
- f. Report any problems relating to maintenance to the church office. The church office will relay the problem to the bus committee chairman.
- g. Observe all posted speed limits.
- 12. Capacity limit for the buses are limited to: Big bus 56 passengers and Mini bus 25 passengers
- 13. New drivers are required to be checked out on buses. The driver must have a road check with a qualified member of the committee.
